



TNVR Clinics and Info

West Georgia Spay Neuter Clinic – Douglasville (West of Good Mews)

- Drop-off Policy: First come, first served
- Limit: 1 cat per person/trapper per day; up to 5 TNR cats per day
- TNR Days: Tuesday and Wednesday only
- Cost: Contact clinic for pricing details

Planned Pethood – Duluth (Northeast of Good Mews)

- Appointments Required: Call 678-561-3491
- TNR Day: Monday only
- Cost: \$60 per TNR cat

Lifeline Animal Project – Two Locations

- Community Animal Center: Atlanta (Southeast of Good Mews)
- College Park Clinic: Near airport
- TNR Days: Monday – Thursday
- Scheduling: View online calendar for availability
- Cost: \$50–\$70 per TNR cat

Project CatSnip – Mobile Unit

- Service Type: Mobile spay/neuter unit
- Appointments Required: Yes — book online
- Cost: \$80–\$100 per TNR cat

Community Cat Clinic – Two Locations

- Woodstock: (North of Good Mews)
- Duluth: (Northeast of Good Mews)
- TNR Days (Woodstock): Wednesday & Thursday only
- Scheduling: Call/text 678-653-8913 or email clientinfo@communitycatclinic.com
- Cost: \$65 per TNR cat

Atlanta Humane Society – Metro Atlanta

- Service Area: Metro Atlanta
- How It Works: Individuals must coordinate with one of AHS's official TNR partners. AHS provides TNR surgeries only to cats enrolled through these partners.
- TNR Days: Varies by partner
- Scheduling: Must go through a partner organization
- Cost: Determined by the partner group

Forsyth County – TNVR Program

(search "TNVR program" for latest info)

- Service Area: Forsyth County
- Program Type: TNVR (Trap-Neuter-Vaccinate-Return)
- TNR Days: Varies based on targeted outreach
- Scheduling: Organized through Forsyth County Animal Shelter and CARE unit
- Cost: No cost to caregivers when part of the county's targeted efforts
- Notes: The CARE unit identifies areas of high community cat populations for service

Douglas County Animal Services – Community Cat Program

(search "Community Cat Program")

- Service Area: Douglas County
- Program Type: Community Cat Program
- TNR Days: Designated by the shelter
- Scheduling: Email animalshelter@co.douglas.ga.us for details and dates
- Cost: Contact for updated pricing (may be free for county residents)
- Notes: Citizens (caretakers) are responsible for basic care. Cats are trapped, brought in on TNR days, and returned post-surgery.
