Daily Care

Clean the shelter, feed the cats, and scoop litter boxes.

Most Needed:

Weekday morning volunteers.

Requirements:

- Ability to commit for at least 6 months.
- Must be at least 8 years old.
- Unbothered by poop.

Meds

Help administer daily medication to our cats. Training provided.

Most Needed:

Weekday morning volunteers.

Requirements:

- Must be at least 21 years old.
- Infinite patience.
- Physical mobility.
- Willingness to learn.



Adoptions

Guide adopters through the adoption process and assist in finding the best matches.

Requirements:

- Must be at least 21 years old.
- Great customer service skills.

Kitty Buddy

Work one-on-one with fearful or shy cats, building their trust through structured interaction.

Requirements:

- Must be at least 18 years old.
- Must have served at least 4 months with Daily Care, Meds, or Adoptions.

Foster

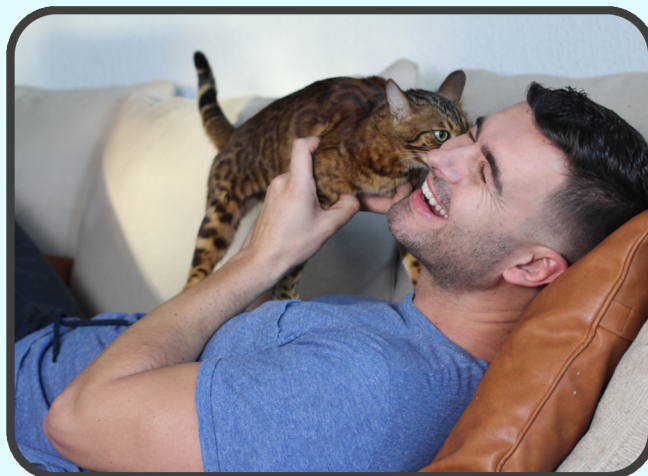
Ranges from caring for bottle-fed kittens to aiding adult cats recovering from medical issues to providing hospice care.

Please Note:

We provide food, some supplies, and all necessary medical care.

Requirements:

- Must be at least 18 years old.

Kitty Hotel Cleaning

Clean and sanitize TNVR traps and cages in our Kitty Hotel.

More Details:

- Only takes about 30 minutes.
- Can be done between 3 PM to 5 PM.
- Sign up at least 24 hours in advance.

Requirements:

- Must be at least 18 years old.
- Able to complete physical tasks
- Previous experience with Daily Care, Meds, or Adoptions.



Surgical

Assist with spay/neuter surgeries and maintain a clean and sanitary surgical environment.

Requirements:

- Must be at least 18 years old.
- Veterinary experience.

Reading to Cats

Help facilitate Reading to Cats sessions, where children come to the shelter to read to our cats.

Requirements:

- Experienced volunteer.
