



## TNVR Spay/Neuter Pre-op Instructions

- Please do not trap a cat for surgery until the day prior to your scheduled surgery appointment.
- Please do not fill out your consent form until **AFTER** you have trapped the cat. (This helps us to know that you have successfully trapped a cat and are bringing it for surgery).
- Drop off is at **7:15 am** at the side door of our building and our address is 3805 Robinson Road, Marietta Ga. We cannot accept drop offs after **7:45 am**.
- They must come in a trap (not a carrier) and only one cat per trap.
- Please wait in your vehicle if you arrive early.
- Keep the trap completely covered with a towel or sheet until we replace it with our own trap cover to minimize stress of the cat.
- Let us know at drop off if you would like any additional services that are not included in the standard TNVR package. The standard package includes: surgery, Rabies and FVRCP vaccine, injectable pain medication, subcutaneous fluids, ear tip. See our website for additional items. We recommend the Parasite Package to treat fleas and all intestinal parasites for \$30.
- Pick up is the same day at **2:00 pm**. Please be on time to be courteous to the volunteers and staff that have been working hard in surgery. Remember to bring your trap cover at pick up.
- **If you were unsuccessful in trapping a cat for your appointment, please send a quick email before 7:00 am to [spayneuter@goodmews.org](mailto:spayneuter@goodmews.org) so we know that you are not coming.** If you would like to try again, we can also reschedule for a later date.
